## 1. Purpose

Mohammad Ali Jinnah University (MAJU) is committed to ensuring that its financial decisions support environmental sustainability, social responsibility, and ethical governance. This policy outlines how the university incorporates sustainability considerations into its investment practices.

## 2. Scope

This policy applies to all university-managed funds, including:

- Operational reserves
- Endowment funds (if applicable)
- Strategic and long-term investments

## 3. Principles

MAJU adopts the following principles in its investment decisions:

### 3.1 Environmental Responsibility

- Avoid investments in industries with significant negative environmental impact (e.g., fossil fuels, pollution-intensive sectors where possible)
- Support investments that promote renewable energy, resource efficiency, and sustainable technologies.

### 3.2 Social Responsibility

- Encourage investments in organizations that uphold human rights, diversity, and fair labor practices
- Avoid entities involved in unethical or harmful social practices

### 3.3 Ethical Governance

- Invest in organizations demonstrating transparency, accountability, and strong corporate governance
- Avoid investments linked to corruption or unethical conduct.

## 4. Implementation

- Investment decisions will consider Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) factors alongside financial performance
- The university will gradually integrate sustainability criteria into all financial planning and procurement processes

- Where possible, MAJU will prioritize partnerships and financial instruments aligned with sustainable development goals

## 5. Oversight

- The university's finance and administration department, in coordination with the Directorate of Sustainability and Environment, will oversee implementation
- Periodic reviews will be conducted to improve alignment with sustainability objectives

## 6. Commitment

MAJU is committed to continuously improving its sustainable investment practices and aligning them with international standards and best practices.

## 7. Review

This policy will be reviewed every 2–3 years to ensure relevance and effectiveness.
